Located in the Haute-Tarentaise, Tignes is divided into 5 hamlets in the Vanoise massif

- Club Med Tignes is located in the liveliest hamlet of Tignes, Val Claret, the ideal place for a festive après-ski.
- Thanks to its perfect location, all the local shops and main events that make up the life of the resort are just a stone's throw away.
- GMs will be able to reach the resort on skis as the Resort is located at the foot of the slopes, so you can enjoy the descent until the last minute!

Lvon: 3h


Chambéry: 2h

The sportiest ski area in the Alps

- In Tignes, winter rhymes with sliding and adrenaline:
- On the sliding side, the traditional downhill skiing, cross-country skiing and snowboarding share the stage with freestyle and freeride, speedriding and many others... The ski area is perfectly fitted out for that between the snowpark, the boardercross, the gliss'park and the 3km Pala'Fou sled trail!
- As for adrenalin, there is something for everyone! A la carte, bungee jumping on skis, paragliding, ice diving, snowmobiling, dog sledding, ice driving and mountain climbing are on the menu.

- The constant excitement of Tignes makes it the ideal winter destination for the whole family.
- The little ones will marvel on board a dog sled, in the Igloo Village or in the snow mazes.
- Teens can try their hand at freestyle or take advantage of the snowtubing course to get the most out of their stay, not forgetting the many events they can take part in during their stay.




Savoy Regional Cuisine

- Lovers of Savoyard cuisine will be able to taste the "persillé de Tignes", a unique 100% local cheese, or enjoy a blueberry tart at 3000m altitude.

300km of trails between Tignes and Val d'Isère

The Tignes ski area has 150km of trails. Once the Tignes - Val d'Isère link is open, skiers can enjoy 300km of trails.

Minimum altitude: 1550 m + Maximum altitude: 3456 m 159 trails for every level, from beginner to expert











Up to 7 months of skiing

- + In winter, the Tignes ski area can open in October thanks to the La Grande Motte glacier which benefits from earlier snow cover than the rest of the resort
- In June and July, skiers have the exceptional opportunity to slide on the glacier in the middle of summer!

Restaurants & Bars

Main Restaurant "Le Val Claret"

A range of 4 spaces with different themes make up the main restaurant, which was designed to evoke a stroll through the mountains from the bottom of the valley to the "Lac".

Gourmet Lounge "Solstice"

For All-Day Dining, the gourmet lounge pays tribute to St. Jean's day and the local tradition dotting the mountains with little fires. It offers, à la carte, in the evening, the flavors of Savoie. It also has a bar and a wine cellar.

The dynamic bar-lounge « Equinoxe »

The bar is divided into two atmospheres, one lively, close to the stage, the other quieter with a fireplace to enjoy the view of the summits.

Outdoor terrace

Ephemeral bar, contemplative and festive terrace depending on the time of day with a view of the resort and the slopes.
