

### Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Monday POINTE-À-PITRE	Spices, flowers, fish and fruit, the local markets abound with colour and exotic produce from this generous island paradise. Passengers boarding and disembarking at this port of call. Ship docked in port.	
Day 2 - Tuesday DESHAIES	On the most lush side of the lle Papillon, Deshaies is a perfect example of the simple charms of Creole life. Time stands still in these tranquil fishing villages surrounded by gentle green hills. At anchor. Beach and water sports.	
Day 3 - Wednesday NEVIS	This tiny volcanic island, sister island to St Kitts, where the traditional sport of cricket remains a national game, is a fascinating world of hot water springs, archeological sites and forests inhabited by green monkies. AShip at anchor, water sports available, beach.	
Day 4 - Thursday ANGUILLA	A long strip of amazingly white sand delicately posed on turquoise water. This miniature island attracts the VIPs of this world, who love its intimacy and discretion. At anchor, beach and water sports.	
Day 5 - Friday SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	A restorative day at sea. Choose from the range of inviting possibilities on our remarkable sailing ship. Lounge on chaise longues, cool off in one of our two swimming pools, work out with a sea view in our Espace Fitness, find instant calm at the spa and enjoy the attentive company of our G.O® team and crew members.	
Day 6 - Saturday SAMANA BAY	Waves of immigration and trade have come to Samana Bay over hundreds of years. Napoleon's troops seized the bay area in the 19th Century, later selling it to the USA. Well-preserved with an authentic historical feel, the bay boasts beaches, mountains and luxuriant plant life. Ship at anchor, no water sports.	
Day 7 - Sunday ÎLE CATALINA	The small island of Catalina, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is known for its coral reefs and pristine beaches rich in white sand. Its turquoise waters make it easy to see coral, multicoloured fish and all the richness of this region. Private beach for the Caribbean Beach Club. Boats at anchor, no water sports.	
Day 8 - Monday LA ROMANA	A little port, built in 1851 to ease maritime traffic. The town was only officially founded in 1897. The city itself only began to grow 20 years later, when Italian immigrants built a large windmill for grinding sugar canes. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

## Excursions of your cruise


Day 2 - Tuesday DESHAIES - BOTANIC GARDEN*	Don't miss the incredible Botanic Garden, based at the former home of the comedian Coluche. You can see a dazzling array of tropical flowers and plants, a breathtaking waterfall and cute little birds from the parrot family. Then we'll round off the trip with an aperitif.	
Day 3 - Wednesday NEVIS / ISLAND HIGHLIGHTS AND BOTANICAL GARDEN*	Visit this charming island - known as the Queen of the Caribees - its historic sites and its 8 acre Botanical Gardens. This highly popular tour includes a visit to Hamilton House, birthplace of Alexander Hamilton, one of the USA's founding fathers. Your tour will also take in the Botanical Gardens, where you can admire one of the biggest and most diverse botanical collections in any tropical region.	
Day 3 - Wednesday NEVIS / HIKING*	Enjoy a 2-hour hike to discover Nevis' lush greenery and natural heritage. You'll have the opportunity to walk through the Rainforest while appreciating the island's flora and fauna. The tour ends on Pinney beach, where a swim will round off this beautiful morning's hiking.	
Day 4 - Thursday ANGUILLA/DÉJEUNER LANGOUSTE À SANDY ISLAND*	Take a short 10-minute boat ride to the stunning Sandy Island, a true tropical paradise. Swim in crystal-clear turquoise waters, explore vibrant reefs, or relax on soft white sand. Enjoy premium food and drinks with effortless luxury. After a blissful day, ferry back to the mainland and rejoin your ship.	
Day 6 - Saturday SAMANA BAY / WHALES OBSERVATION SEAFARI*	Head off in a boat exclusively chartered for Club Med to meet humpback whales. During the mating season, hundreds of humpback whales come to the warm waters of the bay to breed. You will witness the amazing spectacle of the males leaping out of the water and the young whale calves swimming beside their mothers. On the way back, you'll have time to swim and enjoy the fine sandy beach at Cavo Levantado if wanted.	
Day 8 - Monday LA ROMANA / ONE DAY TO PUNTA CANA RESORT (1day)*	Before your flight, enjoy a wonderful day at the Punta Cana Resort, relax on its magnificent coconut palm beach and enjoy the Dominican atmosphere. Day pass from 10.30am to 4pm. Return directly to the airport of Punta Cana.	
Day 8 - Monday LA ROMANA / CAVE OF WONDERS (1/2 day, morning)*	Explore the amazing 240 square metres of the Cave of Wonders. In the midst of stalactites, columns and other rock formations, you will discover ancient drawings left behind by the first indigenous people of the Caribbean. On your way back, you will stop off at La Romana where you can do a spot of shopping at the village market.

#### **Formalities**

#### **HEALTH FORMALITIES**

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
