

Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday FORT-DE-FRANCE	The largest of the French West Indian towns blends cosmopolitan style and local colour, with its urban lifestyle, colourful markets, metal architecture and charming old houses. Stopover for boarding and disembarking. Ship docked in port.		
Day 2 - Sunday DOMINICA	This lush volcanic island, home to the last Caribbean Indians, has almost as many rivers as there are days in the year. Mother Nature reigns supreme. At anchor. Water sports, no beach.		
Day 3 - Monday NEVIS	This tiny volcanic island, sister island to St Kitts, where the traditional sport of cricket remains a national game, is a fascinating world of hot water springs, archeological sites and forests inhabited by green monkies. AShip at anchor, water sports available, beach.		
Day 4 - Tuesday SAINT-BARTHLEMY	A mountainous island that has become a symbol of luxury. A fabulous blend of serenity and upscale tourism, with 17 beautiful beaches. Ship at anchowater sports available, beach.		
Day 5 - Wednesday PRICKLY PEAR / VIRGIN GORDA	Privatization of a beach on Prickly Pear Island for the Caribbean Beach Club day. Guests who have booked the "Virgin Gorda Panoramas" excursion will discover an amazing geological curiosity: large granite boulders softened by erosion, creating natural emerald pools lined with white sand. Boats at anchor, beach and water sports.		
Day 6 - Thursday ANGUILLA	A long strip of amazingly white sand delicately posed on turquoise water. This miniature island attracts the VIPs of this world, who love its intimacy and discretion. At anchor, beach and water sports.		
Day 7 - Friday ANTIGUA	The jagged coast of this former British colony is studded with magnificent beaches. Its typical port, with lively pubs and inns, gives it reams of his charm. At anchor.		
Day 8 - Saturday POINTE-À-PITRE	Spices, flowers, fish and fruit, the local markets abound with colour and exotic produce from this generous island paradise. Passengers boarding and disembarking at this port of call. Ship docked in port.

Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Sunday ROSEAU/ UNUSUAL SWIMS IN DOMINICA (1/2 day)*	Travel to the untamed summits of the island, and after a short walk you will come to a natural rock pool and narrow canyon fed by a waterfall where you can swim surrounded by nature. (Undeveloped natural site). Continue to the village of Wotten Waven, also known as the Wellness Village for its therapeutic pools fed by hot sulphur water. Be sure to take a soothing bath in the midst of fumaroles and porous volcanic rocks.		
Day 2 - Sunday ROSEAU/ NATURAL WONDERS OF DOMINICA (1/2 day)*	Come and enjoy the most popular natural attractions that Dominica has to offer! Spanny Falls are still a bit of a secret, even though they are the height of a 7-story building. Continue on to the Trois Pitons National Park, and cros the forest to the Emerald Pool and its 12-metre waterfall where you can cool off (undeveloped area). You will finally make your way to the village of Trafalgar to the viewing platform to see the majestic waterfalls that the village is famous for before returning to the boat.		
Day 3 - Monday NEVIS / ISLAND HIGHLIGHTS AND BOTANICAL GARDEN*	Visit this charming island - known as the Queen of the Caribees - its historic sites and its 8 acre Botanical Gardens. This highly popular tour includes a visit to Hamilton House, birthplace of Alexander Hamilton, one of the USA's founding fathers. Your tour will also take in the Botanical Gardens, when you can admire one of the biggest and most diverse botanical collections in any tropical region.		
Day 3 - Monday NEVIS / HIKING*	Enjoy a 2-hour hike to discover Nevis' lush greenery and natural heritage. You'll have the opportunity to walk through the Rainforest while appreciating the island's flora and fauna. The tour ends on Pinney beach, where a swim will round off this beautiful morning's hiking.		
Day 4 - Tuesday SAINT BARTH / CATAMARAN (1/2 day)*	Sail north along the stunning coast of St. Barths aboard a luxurious catamaran. Upon reaching the pristine Colombier Bay Nature Reserve, take the opportunity to swim in its crystal-clear waters for an unforgettable experience.		
Day 5 - Wednesday VIRGIN GORDA / PANORAMA (1/2 day)*	The local open-top bus takes the crest route and allows you to enjoy stunning views. A geological surprise lies at the end of the path with strange a tempting granite formations, the "Bath". Natural bathtubs to try before heading to your Caribbean Beach. For information, only passengers who have booked the excursion will have the opportunity to visit Virgin Gorda and the Baths. Panoramic tour by open local bus and walking tour in the Baths. Swimming is prohibited in the event of a red flag.		
Day 6 - Thursday ANGUILLA/ DÉJEUNER LANGOUSTE À SANDY ISLAND*	Take a short 10-minute boat ride to the stunning Sandy Island, a true tropical paradise. Swim in crystal-clear turquoise waters, explore vibrant reefs, or relax on soft white sand. Enjoy premium food and drinks with effortless luxury. After a blissful day, ferry back to the mainland and rejoin your ship.		
Day 7 - Friday ANTIGUA - BALADE DÉCOUVERTE EN 4*4*	The discovery of the island off the beaten track is done in all-terrain vehicles. You will leave the English countryside in the tropics with its authentic charming hamlets and its remains of old refineries attesting to the intense sugar activity before crossing the luxuriant tropical forest. You will not me the swimming break on the magnificent Caribbean coast.		
Day 7 - Friday ANTIGUA - EMERALD CRUISE*	Set sail on a stylish catamaran and cruise along the island's picturesque coastline to discover one of its stunning beaches. Enjoy some free time to swim in the crystal-clear waters or unwind on the soft white sand. Then, hop back on board for a scenic ride to another idyllic beach on the island western shore, where you'll anchor for more swimming and sunbathing. A delicious lobster lunch will be served, perfectly paired with a glass of sparkling wine. To top it all off, an open bar awaits on the return journey—everything you need for a perfect, carefree day at sea.		
Day 8 - Saturday GUADALUPE / BASSE TERRE - THE MAMELLE PARK (1/2 day - morning)*	A superb excursion to discover the fauna and flora in the north of the island: you'll visit the Cascade aux Ecrevisses and walk in the Parc des Mamelles animal park where, if you have a head for heights, you can do the canopy tour.


PTP / ONE DAY AT CLUB MED LA CARAVELLE

Formalities

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
